Since my last knowledge update in January 2022, visa requirements and application processes may change, so it is essential to check the latest information from official sources. When applying for a visa to Turkey, you can follow these general steps:



Visit the official website:

Start by visiting the official website of the <u>Turkish Visa Online Application</u> Ministry of Foreign Affairs or the Turkish Consulate in Norway. The official site will provide the most accurate and up-to-date information.

Choose a visa type:

Determine the type of visa you need. Turkey offers various types of visas, including tourist visas, business visas, and more. Choose the one that best suits your purpose of travel.

Inspection Requirements:

Review the specific requirements for the type of visa you are applying for. Common requirements may include a passport with a minimum of six months validity, a completed application, a passport-sized photograph, flight itinerary, hotel reservation, proof of funds and travel insurance.

Online application:

Many countries, including Turkey, now allow or require online visa applications. Complete the online visa application form with accurate and truthful information. Be prepared to upload all required documents.

Pay fees:

Pay the visa application fee. Fees may vary depending on the type and duration of the visa.
