

The simplest way to find if you basement has a moisture problem or not is to cover your floor with a sheet of impermeable material by sticking it end to end and keeping it overnight or so.

It could be anything ranging from standing water to cracks in the foundation. Whatever the source may be, the seeping of moisture has to be stopped first and then the flooring has to be done. Basement waterproofing can take care of most of your problems resulting from water seepage.

Basement Flooring Options There are various types of flooring options available for wet basements. You can choose any material for your basement flooring like basement ecotile flooring.
